1. INTRODUCTION

These Terms of Reference are to be read in conjunction with the [Governance of College Bodies By-law](#). Both the Governance of College Bodies By-law and these Terms of Reference govern the College Body.

1.1. Established

The Australasian Faculty of Rehabilitation Medicine (AFRM) Regional Committee is established under the authority of the AFRM Council to perform the Functions set out in these Terms of Reference and all matters ancillary to those functions.

2. PURPOSE

The purpose of Australasian Faculty of Rehabilitation Medicine (AFRM) Regional Committee is to advise the Faculty Council on matters relevant to the Faculty in their region.

3. FUNCTIONS

The functions of the Australasian Faculty of Rehabilitation Medicine (AFRM) Regional Committee are:

- a) promote AFRM in their region;
- b) respond to new and emerging AFRM issues relevant to the Faculty as they arise provided the issue is approved by the Faculty President or Faculty Council prior to work commencing; and
- c) work with other relevant appropriate College Bodies and staff in relation to:
 - i. training and continual professional development; and
 - ii. contributing to policy and advocacy matters.

4. MEMBER COMPOSITION

The Membership of the College Body shall comprise up to 9 members, comprising:

4.1. Appointed Members

- Chair, who also sits on AFRM Council
- Regional Training Coordinator
- one trainee, who also sits on the AFRM Trainee Committee
- one Fellow, who also sits on the AFRM Policy & Advocacy Committee
- up to five Fellows, who may be assigned other portfolios as the Committee requires

4.2. Co-opted members

Co-opted members may be appointed for a particular purpose or term.

5. MEETING

This section is to be read in conjunction with the Governance of College Bodies By-law.

5.1. Number of Meetings

The College Body may hold four meetings per calendar year and shall meet face to face (maximum once per year) or by videoconference.

5.2. Chair

The Chair or their appointee will Chair all meetings.

5.3. Quorum

A quorum is one half of the total College Body membership.

5.4. Voting

Decisions will be made by consensus of the majority of members.

5.5. Secretariat

Meeting agenda, supporting papers and minutes or outcomes will be provided prior to the date of the meeting by the Committee members as agreed.

6. REPORTING

The AFRM Regional Committee must report and make recommendations to the AFRM Council as required.

The AFRM Regional Committee is required to provide to the AFRM Council each year:

- a new or updated Work Plan (work plans may be one or two years); and
- a report against the preceding years' work plan.
