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1. INTRODUCTION

These Terms of Reference are to be read in conjunction with the <u>Governance of College</u> <u>Bodies By-law</u>. Both the Governance of College Bodies By-law and these Terms of Reference govern the College Body.

1.1. Established

The Paediatric Research Committee is established under the authority of the Paediatrics & Child Health Division (PCHD) Council to perform the Functions set out in these Terms of Reference and all matters ancillary to those functions.

2. PURPOSE

The purpose of Paediatric Research Committee is to act as the authoritative source within the College with regard to paediatric and community child health research.

3. FUNCTIONS

The functions of the Paediatric Research Committee are:

- a) preparing annually for the approval of the PCHD Council, a proposed list of research related activities;
- b) developing, coordinating, implementing, and monitoring the research-related activity approved by the PCHD Council; and
- c) contributing to research matters in paediatrics and community child health to the College Research Committee.

4. MEMBER COMPOSITION

The Membership of the College Body shall comprise up to 11 members, comprising:

4.1. Ex-officio Members

- Chair, PCHD Education Committee, or their delegate;
- One RACP Grants Advisory Committee representative, a Fellow of the PCHD;
- One Journal of Paediatrics and Child Health Editorial Board representative, a Fellow of the PCHD;
- One Australian Paediatric Surveillance Unit (APSU) representative; and
- One Australian Paediatric Research Network (APRN) representative.

4.2. Appointed Members

Up to six appointed members comprising:

- The Chair of the Committee, a Fellow of the PCHD;
- Four appointed Fellows of the PCHDs, at least one of whom must be resident in Aotearoa New Zealand;
- One trainee of the PCHD;

4.3. Co-opted members

Co-opted members may be appointed for a particular purpose or term.

5. MEETING

This section is to be read in conjunction with the Governance of College Bodies By-law.

5.1. Number of Meetings

The Paediatric Research Committee shall hold a minimum of two meetings per calendar year and shall meet by teleconference, face to face or videoconference.

5.2. Chair

The Chair or their appointee will Chair all meetings.

5.3. Quorum

A quorum is one half of the total College Body membership.

5.4. Voting

Decisions will be made by consensus of the majority of members.

5.5. Secretariat

Meeting agenda, supporting papers and minutes or outcomes will be provided prior to the date of the meeting.

6. **REPORTING**

The Paediatric Research Committee must report and make recommendations to the PCHD Council as required.

The Paediatric Research Committee is required to provide to the PCHD Council each year:

- a new or updated work plan (work plans may be one or two years)
- a report against the preceding years' work plan.
