TERMS OF JUDGMENT/ORDER

The Court notes the first defendant through her counsel giving to the Court the usual undertaking as to damages makes orders in accordance with the document titled short minutes of order which is amended, initialled and dated today by Kunc J and placed with the papers.

Short minutes of order

1. The undertaking of the First Defendant, through her counsel to the Court that she will not act as the President-Elect, and will not hold herself out as the President-Elect, of the Plaintiff for the period of her suspension as a Responsible Person, by the Australian Charities and Not-for-profits Commission.

THE COURT DECLARES THAT:

2. The Board meeting that was purportedly called by the First Defendant at 2:24pm on 22 April 2026 for 2:30pm on 23 April 2026 was invalid for reasons that are not a procedural irregularity for the purposes of s 1322(2) of the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth) and, accordingly, that section does not operate to validate the meeting at which the First Defendant purported to appoint the Second to Fourth Defendants as directors of the Plaintiff.

3. The following persons were not validly appointed directors of the Plaintiff as a result of the purported Board meeting the subject of order 2, and are not directors of the plaintiff.

- the Second Defendant, Professor Abbi Sharma
- the Third Defendant, Mr Antonio Tenaglia
- the Fourth Defendant, Professor John Wilson

4. All resolutions purportedly passed on or after 22 April 2026 and up to and including 27 May 2026 by the Board of the Plaintiff, as purportedly constituted by the First to Fourth Defendants or any one or more of them are invalid.

THE COURT ORDER THAT:

5. The Originating Process filed 15 May 2026 and the Interlocutory Process filed 19 May 2026 are otherwise dismissed with costs reserved.

6 Liberty to any party that seeks an order or notation as to costs to serve and file by email to the associate to Kunc J on or before 12 June 2026:

a submissions not exceeding 2 pages and indicating whether that party consents to costs being dealt with on the papers; and
b any affidavit in support.
