**Cancellation of Royal Australasian College of Physicians Examination**

Dear Sir or Madam

The Royal Australasian College of Physicians' (RACP) annual Divisional Written Examination took place on **19 February 2018**. Due to a technical fault in the operation of the computer-based testing software used, the examination had to be abandoned.

A letter of apology has been issued by the company responsible for the computer based testing. An alternative examination date was set for **02 March 2018**, with an option for those who could not attend on that date to re-sit the examination on **23 March 2018**.

We understand that these circumstances may have required candidates for the examination to alter existing travel arrangements.
