Report Title	Practising during the pandemic

The COVID pandemic has catapulted the use of technology in the delivery of healthcare to the forefront. Telehealth appointments have become an acceptable platform to conduct medical appointments, assisting patients in achieving equitable access to health care. Working in a quaternary care centre, caring for patients post organ transplantation, the digital platform has allowed regular and comprehensive care to continue to be delivered throughout the pandemic. In an attempt to alleviate some of the burden on an overwhelmed health care system, routine investigations are now more frequently performed outside of the hospital setting. The use of the MyHealth platform has allowed physicians to access relevant investigations taken outside the hospital setting. An example is a transplant patient residing in a rural location. Prior to their transplant appointment, it is routine to have bloods and immunosuppression levels taken. Instead of being taken at the hospital at the time of their face to face appointment, routine bloods and immunosuppression levels were completed at a local pathology firm. At the time of the appointment, these results were able to be viewed and actioned as they would be routinely via the My Health Record application, by accessing the pathology function. During the appointment, this therefore allows the titration of medication, based on pathology results.

Report Title	Promoting continuity of care

Lay Summary:

Working in a quaternary transplant centre, patients are referred from a wide geographical catchment which encompasses a vast array of health services. The majority of patients assessed are medically complex with frequent admissions to hospital. At the time of referral for consideration of transplantation, a detailed health summary is provided by the referring physician. However as the transplant assessment process is extensive and occurs over a period of time, it is salient to able to follow the patient's medical journey and access relevant and up to date health records as they become available.

An example of the digital platform improving practice is in the Pre Assessment Transplant Clinic, where patients being considered and waitlisted for organ transplantation are reviewed. During the consultation, recent hospital admissions are discussed and it is imperative to be able to access discharge summaries in an efficient manner, in order to be able to identify new diagnosis, review investigations, reconcile medications and address and enact the follow up plan that was documented in the summary within the consultation. This was the case during a recent consultation, where a peripheral hospital admission led to the diagnosis of a new pulmonary embolism, with the patient commencing on anti-coagulation. In addition, the extensive array of investigations which were also undertaken were concisely documented. Access to this discharge summary and information it pertained, using the My Heath Record tab available on EMR, facilitated timely access to these documents, ensuring in the pre transplant setting the transplant team were privy to all the medical issues that arose and were addressed during the recent admission, and therefore overall promoted continuity of care.
