## Overseas Trained Physicians (OTP) Assessment Subcommittee, Adult Medicine & Chapters

### **Summary**

Fellows from the Adult Medicine Division and Fellows from the Australasian Chapter of Addiction Medicine, the Australasian Chapter of Palliative Medicine or the Australasian Chapter of Sexual Health Medicine in Australia are invited to express their interest in joining the Overseas Trained Physicians (OTP) Assessment Subcommittee, Adult Medicine & Chapters.

## Description

The OTP Assessment Subcommittee play a key role in the assessment of OTPs by determining which physicians can work in Australia. Members of the Subcommittee can have a real impact on health service delivery and quality of care in the Australian health system.

Key responsibilities include:

- Interviewing OTPs to understand their overseas qualifications, training and experience
- Determining, and sometimes modifying, requirements for OTPs to reach the level of an Australian trained physician in accordance with guidelines and policies set by the Medical Board of Australia (MBA) and RACP
- Providing expertise relating to OTP assessment to the MBA, College staff and other College Committees (when required)
- Monitoring of the OTPs progress through to Fellowship
- Advising on key initiatives, projects and educational developments, as requested by the OTP Unit or the Professional Practice Unit.

The Subcommittee meets monthly, up to twelve times per year. Most of the meetings are via teleconference or Zoom with one face-to-face meeting in Sydney.

The Subcommittee is seeking to appoint a Fellow registered to practice in the Adult Medicine Division and/or in the Australasian Chapter of Addiction Medicine, the Australasian Chapter of Palliative Medicine or the Australasian Chapter of Sexual Health Medicine. The Fellow will be appointed initially for a three-year term.
